- develop webinars for engineers, employees, prevention and IT-experts















- collects examples and knowledge about explosion incidents.
























Project Group "Explosion Protection"

already published: explosion safety of bulk material plants - modules "raw material reception" and "storage":










Project Group "Human Factors, Ergonomics and Safe Machines"

- integrates human factors and ergonomics into machinery construction, in workplace and equipment design and in human-system interaction in practice.








Project Group "Human Factors, Ergonomics and Safe Machines"




